If you have cold or flu symptoms seek testing and stay home

WASH YOUR HANDS

KEEP 1.5MAway from others

Vulnerable people are encouraged to stay home to protect their health and talk to their doctor about what is appropriate

11 May

Prepare your CovidSafe plan for all premises and activities, with a <u>checklist for staff</u>, and a <u>small</u> <u>business safety plan</u>

Gatherings (all gatherings must record names and contact details of everyone who attends)

- Online church services only
- **Weddings**: Max 5 people, including celebrant & couple.
- Funerals: Max 10 people, including celebrant & funeral directors. Follow <u>directions for the</u> <u>funeral industry</u>
- No small groups: Including children and vouth
- Pastoral visiting: Pastoral visits to vulnerable people to follow government aged care guidelines
- **Op Shops:** Remain closed
- Offices: Continue working remotely if possible

18 May

Observe CovidSafe plan

Gatherings (all gatherings must record names and contact details of everyone who attends)

- Small gatherings can resume (small groups & church services, bible studies and youth bible studies) up to 10 people. Max 5 visitors to a household.
- Mainly online services (Holy Communion online only)
- **Weddings:** Max 10 people, including celebrant & couple.
- **Funerals:** Max 20 people (indoors) or 30 people (outdoors), including celebrant & funeral directors.
- Church buildings: Open for private prayer
- **Op Shops:** May re-open. Volunteers in vulnerable person categories must have medical clearance to volunteer.
 - Must observe social distancing rules
- Offices: Continue working remotely if possible

13 July

Observe CovidSafe plan

Gatherings (all gatherings must record names and contact details of everyone who attends)

- Church gatherings (small groups & services). Up to 50 ppl indoors or 100 ppl outdoors. Max 5 visitors to a household.
- Weddings and Funerals: Limits as for church gatherings.
- Some **online services** continuing.
- Op Shops: May re-open. Volunteers in vulnerable person categories must have medical clearance to volunteer.
 Must observe social distancing rules
- **Offices:** Return to working from office spaces, with options to continue working remotely as appropriate.

15 June

Observe CovidSafe plan

Gatherings (all gatherings must record names and contact details of everyone who attends)

- Small gatherings can continue up to 20 people.
 Max 5 visitors to a household (subject to review by health authorities).
- **Mainly online services** (Holy Communion services online only will be reviewed by 13 July)
- Activity based children & youth ministries can resume – up to 20 people.
- **Weddings**: Max 20 people, including celebrant & couple.
- Funerals: Max 50 people, including celebrant & funeral directors. Follow <u>directions for the funeral</u> <u>industry</u>
- **Op Shops:** May re-open. Volunteers in vulnerable person categories must have medical clearance to volunteer.
 - Must observe social distancing rules
- Offices: Continue working remotely if possible
